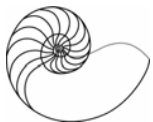

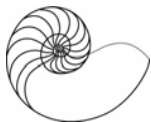
The Canadian Initiative on Frailty and Aging Goals

- ◆ Promote wellness and improve both the quality of health care and of life for older Canadians through prevention, treatment and cost-effective organization of the delivery of care



The Canadian Initiative on Frailty and Aging Objectives

1. Through a systematic review, summarize present state of research on frailty in order to lay down a framework and identify research priorities
2. Propose to clinicians evidence based recommendations on interventions which may prevent, delay or slow progression of frailty
3. Propose recommendations to policy makers
4. Propose recommendations to population

- ◆ Through this process, develop a working framework



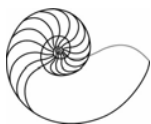
